

Surveys and the Development of New Sunday School
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These are a few of the following questions that we put in our survey of adult, youth and children attendees as well as parents of children attendees:

1. What are you looking for in Sunday School classes?
2. How are we doing in discussing (relevant) issues pertaining to your everyday lives?
3. Why do you believe it's important to provide different classes in the Sunday School Ministry?

At the time before this survey was done, we had the following Adult Classes (Adult 1 - Age 40-54, Adult 2 - Age 55 to Whenever, and Adult 3 - 18 to 30 Something). After the feedback from our Adult Division, Youth Division, and Parents of the Children Division the following new classes were created.

Mom's and Babies Class: Expectant Moms and Moms with newborn children could continue their Sunday School classes and have the tools needed in the classroom to support the needs of their child. As they discuss "scripture" and relevant issues that they are experiencing as new parents.

Married Ministry Class: Married Couples that wanted a Sunday School class to discuss everyday relevant issues that pertain to their marriage using the lesson scripture of the day.

Men's Ministry Class: Men of the church coming together in a Sunday School Class using the Sunday School Curriculum and scripture, to discuss relevant issues within their everyday lives that pertain to Men.
